
As the Southwest Area Transportation Committee (SWAT) answers the Metropolitan Transportation Commission "call for projects" for the 2013 Regional Transportation Plan (due April 5), the Alamo Improvement Association asks the County to refrain from submitting projects that would widen Alamo's main roads and intersections.

We note that the 2009 Regional Transportation Plan of the Contra Costa Transportation Authority, which will be used as a starting point for the 2013 RTP update, includes a request of \$30 million for Project #22613, "Widen and extend major streets, and improve interchanges in southwest Contra Costa County" on the County's committed list of projects.

AIA also asks which major streets and intersections in southwest area are included in Project #22613.
